Preschool Registration Form Instructions

- **Universal Pre-K Option:** Pied Piper School has been offering high quality education to the Yorktown area since 1979. We understand that some parents will choose to go the Universal Pre-K route provided by the Young Men's Christian Association(YMCA) in Yorktown and we understand that decision. All that we ask, as a family and school, is that you please do NOT sign up and take a spot in the Pied Piper Pre-K program if you intend to send your child to UPK. We appreciate your understanding and respect any decision you make.
- **Updates for the 2024-2025 school year:** When submitting your registration form, the \$100 insurance fee and one month deposit are due to secure your spot for the 2024-25 school year. For currently enrolled students, the deposit is due but if you are unable to make both payments (February 2024 tuition/ 2024-25 deposit) please speak to Max and we can move your February 2024 tuition to be paid in June 2024. Once your spot is secured we will put all paperwork through our system. **IF** you pull your paperwork before May 1st 2024 you will receive half your deposit back but **IF** you pull your paperwork after April 30th, 2024 you will forfeit your entire deposit for the 2024-2025 school year. Please speak to Max if you have any questions, it can certainly be confusing.
- Each student enrolled within the program requires their own registration form. Siblings cannot be combined on one form. Fill out the entire front side including all emergency numbers and phone numbers in case we need to contact you. Make sure the "Emergency Contacts" are NOT the parents, we always call the parents first.
- If your child has any allergies please make sure you list all of them and if they need an EpiPen for those allergies. Any child requiring an EpiPen must have the necessary forms from their pediatrician on file at the school along with their EpiPen prior to their first day. As per state law, all EpiPen's are required to be in the original packaging WITH the original pharmacy label on the box. Please allow 24 hours minimum for paperwork to be processed by the main office.
- Please list any authorized persons who will provide transportation for your child, not including parents/guardians. We require a list of these authorized persons on file at the school in order to allow for pickup with identification.
- To enroll, all parents are required to sign the bottom of the registration form indicating they have read and understand the Policies and Procedures document accompanying this form as well as the section of this form labeled "Agreement".
- Be sure your registration form indicates the program you are requesting (half day, full day, daycare and extended). Remember that there are different sections for the 2's program and the 3's/4's programs, please ensure to mark the correct section based on your child's age as of 09/01/2024.

Notice for Incoming Pre-K Students



The Pied Piper family understands that you have an important decision to make regarding where your child will spend the next year before they go off to kindergarten. For students in multiple districts including Yorktown, you will have the option to send your child to the universal Pre-K program funded by New York state. We understand the appeal of this program, and the draw of a free solution when childcare and private education, for most families, is a considerable expense.

We understand how difficult it is for families to afford private education and childcare, however, we feel it is important that you are able to make an informed decision about what is best for your child. Please remember that the universal Pre-K program is not run or managed by the Yorktown School district. The program is run by the YMCA, and staffed by YMCA staff. The YMCA is running the program out of the French Hill School, a school which has not been used for district students in many years and which was deemed by the district as being too far below code to be re-opened and used as additional elementary classrooms for district students. We encourage you to visit the site, look into the program, and decide what is best for your family and your child, as you would any other preschool program because although you apply through the district, it is not a district run program or a district run facility.

When you choose Pied Piper for your child, you get a curriculum, a facility, and a staff that is not provided anywhere else. At Pied Piper, your child will have access to...

- Whole school live music twice per day as well as three times per week individualized classroom music instruction
- Individualized classroom art class three times per week
- Physical education classes four times per week with developmentally appropriate equipment and curriculum
- Special presenters from the community including dentists, police officers, and firefighters
- Field trips to community locations such as Stuart's Apple Farm, Muscoot Farm, East Coast Sports Complex, John. C Hart Library, and Uncle Guissepes



Our facility is in compliance with all local and state codes, and recently renovated to include more space and more specialized facilities for your children including...

- Three outdoor playgrounds
- A turf play space
- Half court basketball space
- Gaga ball pit
- Covered outdoor patio space and playground for year-round play in all kinds of weather
- Skylights and windows for plenty of natural light
- Three large classrooms, filled with age appropriate, engaging, and enriching toys and equipment
- Specialized enrichment centers for fine motor play, gross motor play, literacy, dramatic/imaginative play, and cooperative play
- Multiple bathrooms in each classroom
- Pet areas with classroom pets
- Learning centers for small group, structured lessons and workbooks
- Technology center featuring an Obie Interactive Playground Projector with a variety of fun and educational games

Any payment made on or after the 15th of the month is subject to a 5% or \$50 late fee(whichever is less). I understand tuition is due for the entire school year (September through June). June 2025 tuition is due with your registration form. We must be notified prior to May 1st, 2024 if you are withdrawing your child from the program to be eligible for a partial refund of 1/2 of your deposit (Reg.Fee+One Month). Notification after April 30th, 2024 results in a forfeiture of your deposit. No Exceptions.

In case of an accident, I agree that emergency medical care may be given in the event the person/persons designated above cannot be reached.
