









*Reminder: ALL NEW AM or Full Day STUDENTS ARRIVE AT 9:15 AM so we can give those students individual attention at arrival. If your child is new to school, or is working on separation from parents, please plan to arrive early for dismissal at 11:35 (am only) and 2:50 (full day or pm only) respectively as this helps reduce anxiety during the dismissal process when grownups begin to arrive. This helps ensure all students have a positive experience through the transition and acclimation process.
