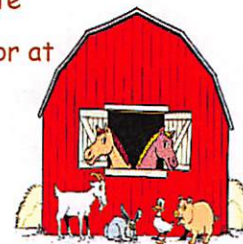
**FRI. Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>** Class Color Wars. Wear your class t-shirt and get a prize! Winning class gets bragging rights.
